Minutes: Covid restrictions stopped us holding an AGM in 2021 so there were no minutes to be read. However, it was pointed out that the documents and reports prepared for the 2020-21 year were posted on the Rotorua U3A website, and that would also apply for the 2021-22 year.

President's Report: Whilst the total membership is down, gender equality is improving, now 67% f and 33% m compared with 73%.f and 27% m some 8 years ago. 97% of members are now on email. The rent for the Bridge Club rooms was less than budgeted because 2 forums were cancelled because of covid restrictions.
